It's powered by a four-litre six-cylinder boxer engine capable of reaching up to 550 hp. The car features improved aero, more of a focus on drivability, advanced optimisation to safety features and reductions in servicing and parts costs. All the 991.2 racing cars have normally aspirated 4-litre engines. Compared to the 991.1 GT3 R, the 991.2 GT3 R engine offers a broader usable rev range and the engine response is more precise due to 6 throttle butterflies. The roof, front hood and fairing, wheel arches, doors, side and tail sections, rear lid and interior trim are made of carbon-fibre reinforced plastic (CFRP).
